Currently, 58.9% of the 3,469 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 35.2%, renter occupied; and 5.9% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 58.2% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 31.8% are renter occupied; and 10.0% are vacant. In 2020, there were 3,442 housing units in the area and 6.4% vacant housing units. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2020 is 0.24%. Median home value in the area is \$244,039, compared to a median home value of \$283,272 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.64% annually to \$278,059.
